

Voice

1. The use of illegally photocopied music is not permitted. Photocopies or computer-generated copies will not be accepted unless they show legal authorization from the publisher or copyright holder. Failure to show authorization will result in disqualification. Please note that copyright/photocopy regulations also apply to all accompanists. **Note: Copyright law states that one photocopy may be made for personal use from a personally owned original. This new legislation allows a performer to use a photocopy while giving her/his original copy to the adjudicator. Photocopies may not be presented to the adjudicator.**
2. **Open alumni** classes are for those students who have won the senior “Top Vocalist” award. Former top vocalists are not eligible to receive the “Top Vocalist” award a second time, but are eligible to receive the “Alumni” award. Only **one** Alumni award will be presented.
3. Introductory levels in certain Non-Competitive classes are for younger participants only. Use Conservatory material only. All other **non-competitive** classes are for any age.
4. Grade levels refer to Royal Conservatory or Conservatory Canada Syllabi and all Own Choice material must be chosen from either syllabus. Exceptions to this rule are for the following classes only: 1) Traditional (True) Folk Songs, 2) Sacred or Spiritual Solos (not Oratorio), 3) Operetta, 4) Musical Theatre, 5) Disney Theatre & Disney Film, 6) Film Music, 7) Recital Class, 8) Jazz Solo
5. All competitors interested in obtaining monetary awards must enter and perform in at least 4 solo classes including a General Solo (V 100) in the grade level being studied.
6. Recital Class - Section V 300: Selections other than those listed in the Conservatory Syllabi will be accepted - other than popular music. Competitors will be judged on the discrimination shown in the choice of selection/selections as well as presentation, vocal technique and interpretation.
7. No substitution may be made once application is submitted. This will result in competitor becoming non-competitive and no mark will be given by the adjudicator.
8. Selections **must** be memorized.
9. The festival committee reserves the privilege of perusing any selection to determine satisfaction of standards.
10. Only live piano accompaniment may be used.
11. Selections and arrangements from the Royal Conservatory syllabus must be from the **2012 Edition**.
12. V2000 Music Theatre Provincial/National Qualifying Class. This class is for high-level Musical Theatre competitors with sights on recommendations to the provincial competition and the hope of a provincial recommendation to the national festival. Only the V2000 has the potential to lead someone to the Nationals for Music Theatre. Students competing in the V1900 Musical Theatre classes will be recommended to Provincials in the regular stream. The V1900 stream will lead to the Provincials but not to the Nationals.

General Solos

This category must be entered in order to qualify for a monetary award. All own choice selections must be from RCM or Conservatory Canada. One selection only. Competitor must be studying grade level entered. Popular music selections (list C/D/F) from the 2012 RCM Syllabus, including musical theatre and film songs, are not permitted in this group.

Vowels should be changed according to phrasing. Attention to vocal tone, intonation, breath management, articulation, dynamics, and phrasing is expected. Vocalises need not be memorized and may be transposed. Students may not enter a class below grade being studied. Selections must be from either the RCM or CCM Syllabus.

V 2000 Music Theatre Provincial/National Qualifying Class

1. Must be under the age of 28 as of December 31, 2013.
2. Competitors will perform the following repertoire:
 - One selection must be a Music Theatre Ballad
 - One selection must be a Music Theatre Up-Tempo

Make sure that your selections will not exceed the time limit as noted in #6 below.
Movie musicals and animated movie musical numbers are not permitted.

3. Performance times MUST be included on the entry form. Please ensure costume changes are factored into this calculation.
 4. Costumes are permitted.
 5. Song selections must be gender and age appropriate.
 6. Time limit: 20 minutes (including costume changes)
 7. Piano accompaniment only.
 8. One small stage prop (eg. small table) and one hand prop (eg. broom) are permitted as long as no set-up is required.
 9. It is expected that the 1st and 2nd place winners of the Provincial/National Qualifying Class will proceed to the Provincial Finals and if they win there, to then be available to compete at the National Music Festival.
- Provincial Note:** You will be required to sing one ballad, one up-tempo (as sung at the local competition) and one own choice from standard Music Theatre repertoire.
- Nationals Note:** You will be required to perform one ballad, one up-tempo, one selection from the Tin Pan Alley Era, one selection from the Golden Age and one selection from contemporary music theatre repertoire - three of which must have been performed at the provincial competition. A Sondheim selection is suggested at this level.
10. To be eligible for an award, competitors must enter a minimum of four classes and receive a minimum mark of 85. Therefore, at least three other voice classes must be entered.
